Ms. Wang is a professional geo-hazards and resilience engineer with extensive experience in policy development and collaborating with public and private stakeholders.

In her talk, Ms. Wang will challenge engineers and other professionals to develop new and transformative approaches for improving society’s resilience to disasters. To prevent severe critical infrastructure failures and minimize the detrimental societal effects from natural hazards, we need to develop new coordinated approaches among system designers and operators to better understand, integrate, and control the service deliveries.
